

Create a Hi-Res PDF file from Quark 7

PDF Export for Mac

1. Download and unstuff the Wright's PDF Output Style

2. Setup the default PDF preferences

- Go to the QuarkXPress pull down menu and choose Preferences.
- Select PDF. Verify that the PDF Workflow is set to Direct to PDF.

3. Import the PDF Output Style

- Under the Edit menu, choose Output Styles.
- Click the Import button. Locate the output styles that were downloaded in step 1.
- Select an output style and click Open. When you are done loading all of the output styles, click the Save button.

4. Export to PDF

- Open the document.
- Be sure all hi-res are linked and all necessary fonts are active.
- Also check that all bleeds are opened 1/8" (.125) past the trim guides.
- Under the File menu, go to Export, then Layout as PDF.
- PDF Style - Select the appropriate output style. ('Wright's CMYK' PDF Output or 'Wright's CMYK+Spot' PDF Output)
- Click Save to create the PDF.

Note: You may need to adjust some of the settings for custom output.

5. Open the PDF to inspect for accuracy.

Create a Hi-Res PDF file from InDesign CS3

PDF Export for Mac

1. Download and unstuff the Wright's PDF 1.4 CS Preset

2. Load the PDF Export Preset

- Under the File menu, choose PDF Export Presets > Define.
- Select the Load button. Locate the Wright's PDF 1.4 CS Preset which was downloaded in step 1.
- Click OK after loading the preset.

3. Export the PDF

- Under the File menu, choose Export.
- Name the PDF and click the Save button.
- Choose the Wrights PDF 1.4 CS Preset, click the Export button.

Note: You may need to adjust some of the settings for custom output.

4. Open the PDF to inspect for accuracy.
